'Some sort of agreement with life'

If you've ever driven to Josiahs Bay very, very early in the morning, you might have seen a small, white-haired lady walking quickly down the road as though she were on a mission.

Most likely, she would have been wearing white tennis shoes and carrying a plastic bag or two. She might have given you a quick glance and a wave, but her eyes otherwise would have remained glued to the side of the road.

Meet Nancy Reynolds, who will turn 90 in March, but who leaves it to others to obsess about her age.

Six days a week, the Pennsylvanian walks from her house above the Tamarind Club to the beach, picking up every bit of trash that she encounters along the way. (She takes one day off every week, because on Tuesday mornings she and her husband Wilson drive to town early in order to beat the traffic rush.)

On vacation

The habit started when the couple stayed in Josiahs Bay on vacation almost 20 years ago and noticed the road was littered with garbage. "We borrowed a wheelbarrow from Elihu Rhymer and we took five loads of trash," Ms. Reynolds told me. Later, when the Reynolds bought a house in Josiahs Bay and started spending half of each year here, she began making her pilgrimage regularly.

"Then I got to be known as the bag lady," she said, laughing. Now, almost everyone recognises her. Once, when a storm was coming, she accepted a rare lift: "I said, 'I live near the Tamarind. Just drop me off there. They said, 'we know where you live.'"

Friends

Roberta Laauwe and Bob Heath, two other wintertime

Josiahs Bay residents who sometimes join Ms. Reynolds on her walks, first met the older couple on the road. "I said, 'I don't want to walk with them. They'll slow us up,'" Ms. Laauwe said, adding that, when they joined them anyway, "it was all we could do to keep up with them, especially coming up the hill."

Ms. Laauwe also related another story about her friend: "One day we were walking down the road ... and we saw her coming out of the bushes."

Reynolds had been picking up trash that had been tossed away from the roadside.

"We refused to do it because you get all that creepy stuff on you," Ms. Laauwe said; but when they scolded Ms. Reynolds for going off the road, "She said, 'never mind I'm going to do it when you go.'"

The walk

On Monday, there wasn't much trash on the road, and Ms. Reynolds supposed it had been a slow weekend. Still, she spotted a bottle, a beer can, a fast food bag, and several other small bits of garbage, and quickly stuffed them into her plastic bag. When I crossed to the left side of the road to pick up an empty oil can, she started. "I saw that yesterday," she said, "and I was going to pick it up."

Then she pointed into the bushes, where several bottles and cans lay out of reach in the

underbrush.

"You see, if you're going to get that stuff in there, you have to go back in there, but once you're back in there, it's not that bad," she said.

When I found a plastic bag with a ripe mango in it and asked if we should keep it, she hung the bag on a fence post. "We'll leave that out and think about it," she said. (When we returned, she advised me to take the mango home, adding that it was a rare find — she couldn't remember another time when she'd found anything useful.)

'Someone ancient'

Ms. Reynolds knew almost everyone we met along the way.

A man standing in his yard

called out to her. A handful of cars beeped friendly hellos. A man cleaning the beach at Josiahs Bay took off his glove and shook her hand. A woman walking three dogs stopped for a chat and introduced her to a new dog.

"One of the reasons I do all this, [is if] people see someone ancient walking up and down the road, that's going to inspire them to not throw stuff out," she said.

It just might be working: When she first started cleaning the road, she often found entire bags full of trash, she said; now, such a find is rare. Ms. Reynolds said she feels lucky to be able to make the daily walks.

"Being old is really a great time of life," she said. "It's just nice. You come to some sort of agreement with life and it's just nice."

Of course, many people feel differently, she said, but added that enthusiasm is contagious: "It's kind of like picking up garbage. If you give people the idea, they'll catch on."
